

Dr. Carlos Juiz received the B.Sc., M.Sc and Ph.D. degrees in Computer Science in 1988, 1992 and 2001, respectively from the University of Balearic Islands (UIB), Spain. He has a postgraduate degree on Office automation from the Polytechnic University of Madrid, Spain (1993). Before joining as Assistant Professor in the Department of Mathematics and Computer Sciences (UIB), he had several positions related with the computer systems industry. From 1990 he was Systems Analyst in Xerox, leaving this position as Senior Analyst in 1999. From 1995 to 1999 he shared his time between the University of Balearic Islands and several positions in Xerox. He was visiting researcher at Department for Computer Science and Business Informatics, University of Vienna, during 6 months in 2003. His research interest mainly focuses on systems performance modelling, web performance engineering and ambient intelligence middleware.

He has been involved in several regional (3), national (8) and international (14) research projects. He has participated in numerous international conferences, workshops and congresses as reviewer, session chair (14), programme committee member or scientific committee member (143) and president of the program committee (4). He has given over 25 talks in conferences and seminars at international universities. He is co-author of more than 100 international papers (29 journals, 19 published reviews and 72 proceedings and book chapters) and one university textbook. Carlos Juiz has given 10 international seminars and 23 conferences at prestigious universities in the world.

He was editor special issues in international journals (4) and permanent reviewer of the IEEE Latin America Journal, the ACM Computing Reviews, the IEEE Journal of Computing, the Journal of Supercomputing, Journal of Information Sciences, the Future Generation of Computer Systems and Simulation Practice and Theory among others.

Dr. Carlos Juiz has been also reviewer of FONDECYT research programme from Chilean Ministry of Science and Technology in 2006. Carlos Juiz is member of the IEEE and also member of the Steering Committee of the Workshop of Software and Performance (WOSP) since he co-organized this international workshop in 2005. He organized the international Workshop on Middleware and Performance (WOMP 2006) and the European Performance Engineering Workshop (EPEW 2008). He cochaired the program of the joint WOSP/SIPEW conference in 2010.

He is also member of ARTEMISIA (Advanced Research & Technology for Embedded Intelligent Systems Industrial Association) and member of the standardisation committee of NESSI (Networked European Software and Services Initiative). He was awarded the 2003 International Multiconference in Computer Science and Computer Engineering presented by the World Academy of Sciences. He is also invited expert of the International Communication Union (ITU). He is Senior Member of ACM since 2010. He is Spanish representative of TC5 at IFIP.

He was Sub-director of the Polytechnic School (2004-2005) and Director of the Office of Planning and Prospective at University of the Balearic Islands (UIB) (2005-2007). He was the President's Delegate of New Technologies from 2007 until 2011.

Currently, he is Vice-Rector for IT at UIB and Associate Professor at the Computer Science Department. He is visiting Associate Professor at BMIR in Stanford University.
